


BFIS EC/ES Behavior Policy

TIER 1

Uncooperative/Noncompliant Behavior



Infractions

A1: Failing to be in one's assigned place on school premises

A2: Behaving in a manner which disrupts the educational process (example: making excessive noise in a classroom, library or hallway, talking out of turn, chewing gum, drinking/eating during class, refusing to work, not being prepared for class)

A3: Engaging in verbally rude or disrespectful behavior(example: mild profanity, Excessively affectionate behavior with another student)

A4: Using school computer, telephones, PA system, copy machines or other electronic devices without appropriate permission.

A5: Chewing gum/ Drinking/Eating during class

A6: Using personal cellphones during school hours without appropriate permission.

Infractions

B1: Using profane, obscene, vulgar, or lewd language, gestures or behaviors (N-5th)

B2: Lying to, forging, giving false information to, and/or misleading school personnel

B3: Misusing property belonging to others (Nursery-2nd)

B4: Engaging in or causing disruptive behavior or Disrespectful behavior towards a member of the BFIS community (Excessive)

B5: Leaving class or school premises without permission of supervising school personnel; Excessive tardies to class during one semester

B6: Engaging in inappropriate or unwanted physical contact or touching someone in a private part of body (N-2nd)

B7: Inappropriate use of electronic technology (example: unauthorized audio/video recording)

B8: Academic integrity (cheating first time) (4th-5th)

B9: Shoving, pushing, or engaging in a minor altercation or similar physical confrontational behavior towards students or school personnel (e.g., pushing past another person), or throwing an object (e.g., chalk) or spitting at another person or threatening harm (Nursery – 2nd)	
B10: Gambling on Campus (Grades 3-5)	
B11: Repeated offenses (equaling defiance) or more serious instances of Tier 1 Infractions.

Infractions

C1: Using slurs based upon actual or perceived race, ethnicity, color, national origin, citizenship, weight, religion, gender, gender identity, gender expression, sexual orientation or disability (3rd-5th)

- C2: Shoving, pushing, or engaging in a minor altercation or similar physical confrontational behavior towards students or school personnel (e.g., pushing past another person), or throwing an object (e.g., chalk) or spitting at another person or threatening harm (3rd-5th)
- C3: Knowingly possessing property belonging to another without authorization (3rd-5^{th)}) For cases involving more serious incidents or stealing, please see D.6)
- C4: Tampering with, changing, or altering a record or document of a school by any method, including, but not limited to, computer access or other electronic means (3rd-5th)



Aggressive/Harmful Behavior



Infractions

D1: Posting or distributing, displaying, or sharing literature or material containing a threat of violence, injury or harm, or depicting violent actions against or obscene, vulgar or lewd pictures of students or staff (including posting such material on the Internet)

- D2: Engaging in physically aggressive behavior other than minor altercations which creates a substantial risk of or results in minor injury
- D3: Engaging in an act of coercion or threatening or instigating violence, injury or harm to another or others
- D4: Engaging in harassing, intimidating, and/or bullying behavior, including using electronic communication to engage in such behavior (cyber-bullying); such behavior includes, but is not limited to: physical violence; stalking; verbal, written, or physical conduct that threatens another with harm; seeking to coerce or compel a student or staff member to do something; hazing; taunting; exclusion from peer groups designed to humiliate or isolate; using derogatory language or making derogatory jokes or name calling to humiliate or harass

D5: Making sexually suggestive comments, innuendoes, propositions or similar remarks, or engaging in nonverbal or physical conduct of a sexual



Seriously Dangerous or Violent Behaviors



Infractions

- E1: Starting a fire or possession or use of fireworks, smoke bombs, or stink bombs, etc.
- E2: Threatening to use or using force to steal or attempt to steal property belonging to another
- E3: Using force against, or inflicting or attempting to inflict serious injury against school personnel or school safety agents
- E4: Using extreme force against or inflicting or attempting to inflict serious injury upon students or others
- E5: Planning, instigating, or participating with another or others, in an incident of group violence
- E6: Engaging in physical sexual aggression/compelling or forcing another to engage in sexual activity
- E7: Possession of ,selling or distributing illegal drugs or controlled substances and/or tobacco and alcohol
- E8: Attending school under the influence of alcohol or drugs.
