

BUS RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1.** All ES students should be accompanied by an adult whilst waiting for the morning bus. Accordingly, all ES students should be met by an adult in the afternoon when descending at their stop. If there is no adult at the stop to meet the bus, the child must **STAY ON THE BUS** and will be brought back to school. Please remind young children not to get off the bus if there is no one there to meet them.
- 2.** Please note that the expectations for student behavior on the bus are the same as those upheld at school. Students who do not act respectfully and follow directions given by the bus monitors may be asked to stop using school transportation. Disruptive behavior can be dangerous and will be view as a serious offence.
- 3.** In the interest of safety, all students must wear seatbelts.
- 4.** Trash should never be left on the bus.
- 5.** If your child leaves something on the bus, please contact us immediately and we will do our best to coordinate with the bus company to find the misplaced item.
- 6.** Please remember that the bus monitor and driver are on the bus to assure that safety and correct behavior are observed. They are to be respected, as you would want them to respect you.

Any conduct that endangers the safety of the students on the bus will result in a phone call and letter to the parents, the student will also be removed from the bus for a period of one week.

All other violations of bus rules will result in a warning letter being sent to the parents outlining the student's behavior. After a second warning the student will be removed from the bus for one week. Additional violations will result in additional suspension from the bus and may result in the student being removed permanently from the bus.
